Did you know that during WWII the United States in general established 175 Prisoners-of-War (POW) camps? Most notable camps include Fort McCoy and Camp Fort Sheridan. In Wisconsin, alone, there were 38 camps that housed a total of 20,000 POW's. This presentation is an overview of US POW camps and specific information regarding Wisconsin POW camps.
