Monthly Events

Luncheon Programs: OWLS luncheon events include delicious hot catered meals followed by an enjoyable one-hour program presented by either subject experts, actors, or musical groups.

Luncheons are held in the *fully accessible* Fellowship Hall at COMMUNITY United Methodist Church (CUMC) located at 14700 Watertown Plank Road, Elm Grove, WI 53122. The facility is just one mile from Brookfield Square Shopping Mall, has free parking, and can accommodate socially distanced seating.

Prices vary by program based on the costs of the meal and entertainment. Most prices range from \$20-\$30 except for the special offsite Holiday Celebration in December. Participants can choose to just attend the program at the published rate.



Day Trips: Five excursions are scheduled this year including the popular "Mystery Trip" to a surprise destination. Highlights of the other trips include:
